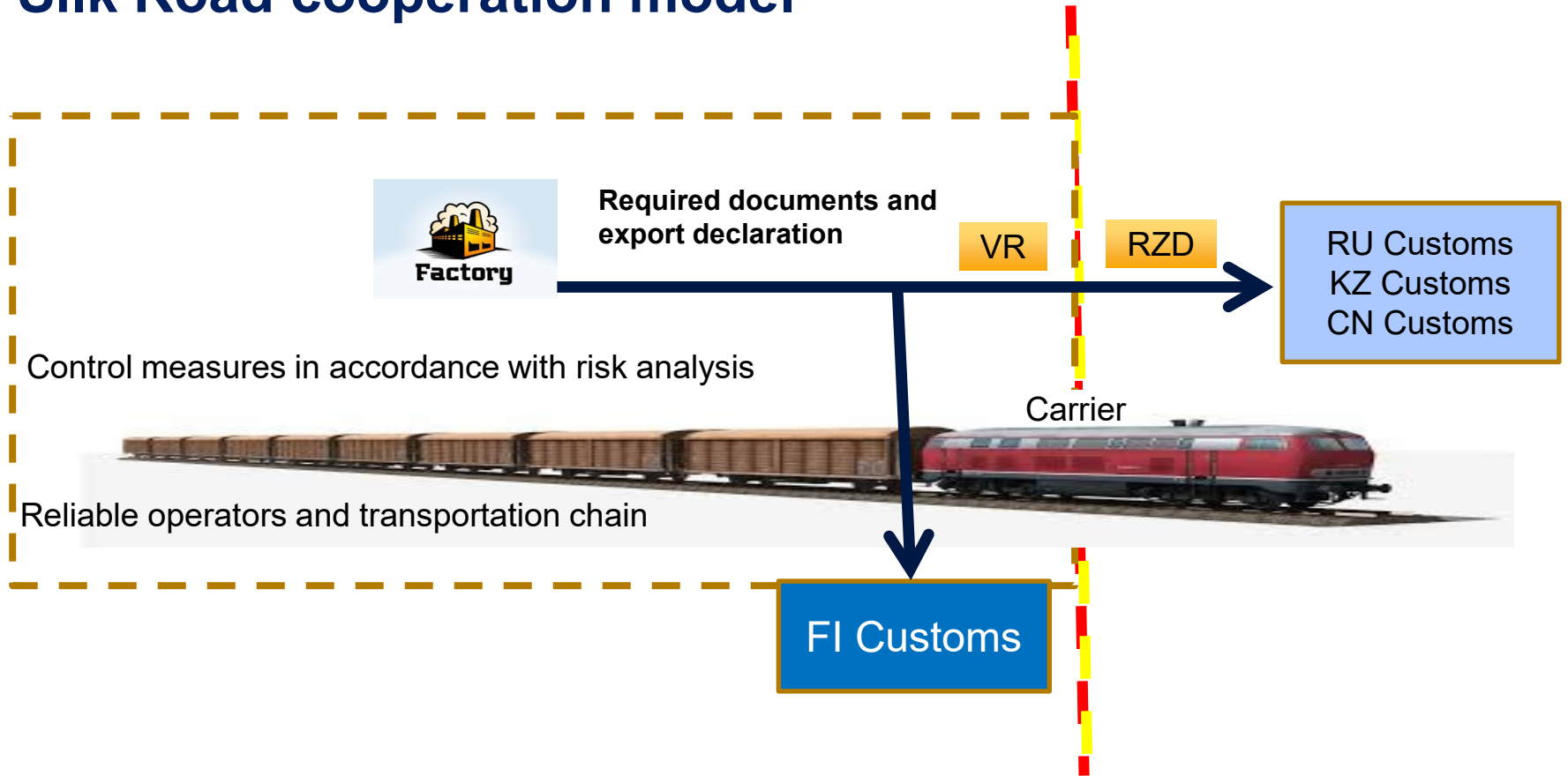
Background on Customs cooperation and framework conditions of the Silk Road project

- Meetings with experts and other meetings (four-party and bilateral) since the beginning of 2015
- Information exchange is part of the Commission's exclusive competence
 - National simplifications are no longer possible within the Union

Aims of the customs administrations in the Silk Road project

- A smooth customs clearance process in three different areas of legislation
- Ensuring correctness of information in the transportation chain
- Speeding up border crossings
- Ensuring the security of the transportation chain

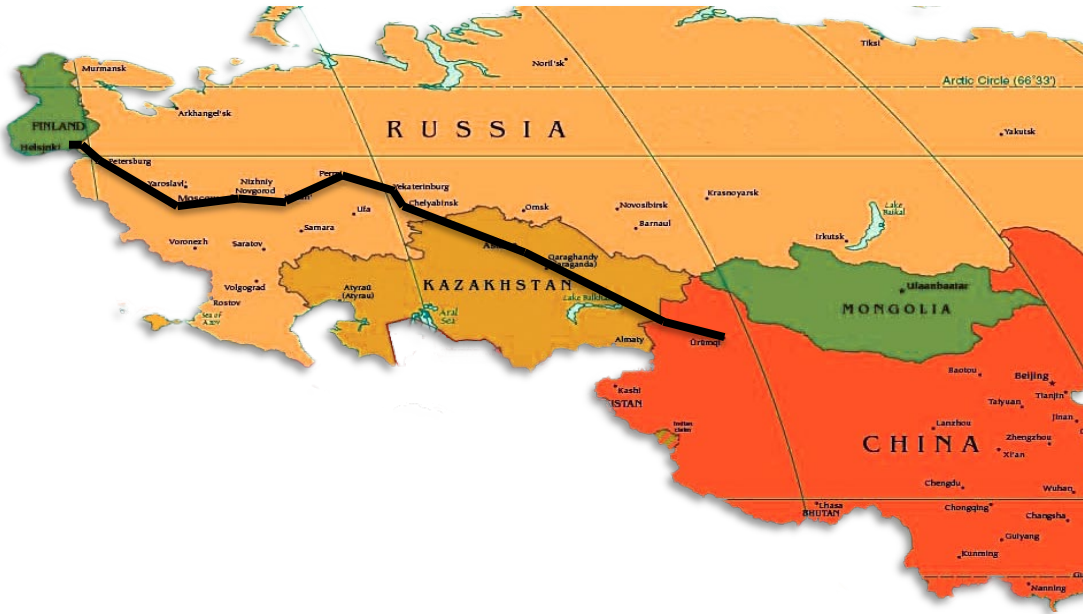
Silk Road cooperation model



Future actions within the framework of the Silk Road project

- Signing a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)
- Drafting additional technical records
- Risk analysis based on information received in advance
- Looking into the possibility of just one transit declaration for the whole train
